EBT benefits to purchase fresh fruits and vegetables at authorized farmers markets and stands are available from June through September.

**SENIOR FARMERS' MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM (SFMNP)** provides eligible Chickasaw seniors, Chickasaw Warrior Society members and Chickasaw citizens who are considered 100% disabled with EBT benefits to purchase fresh fruits and vegetables from authorized farmers markets and farm stands. First American seniors age 55 and older and seniors 60 and older living in a First American household may also be eligible for these EBT benefits. Participants must reside in the Chickasaw Nation or the Oklahoma City area.


