

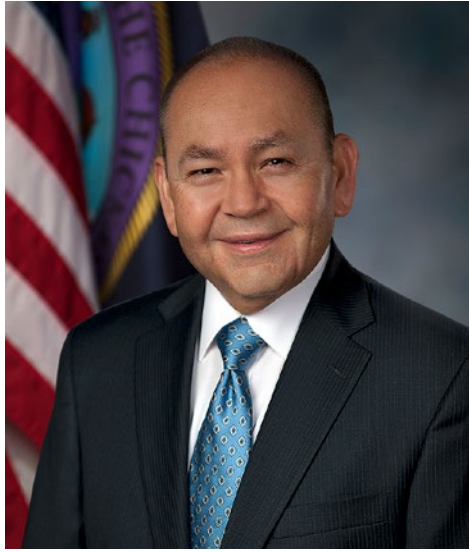

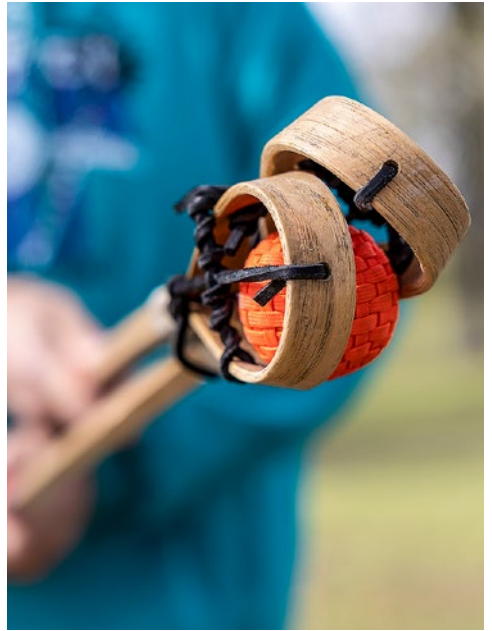

Chickasaw youth are invited to an intensive exploration of various artistic fields, career preparatory programming and student-oriented skill development on the East Central University (ECU) campus. The academy emphasizes Chickasaw and other Southeastern tribal cultures through visual and performing arts.

An arts gala and showcase conclude the academy, giving students the opportunity to display their work and perform with their new or strengthened skills. The arts gala is a public reception to highlight the visual arts disciplines. The showcase is a public performing arts event incorporating all the performing arts disciplines into a final production.

The **STARTING ARTS ROTATION (STAR) (AGES 8-10)** is a two-week day academy facilitated by professional artists. Students begin training in the arts with instruction tailored for their age and skill levels.

CHICKASAW ARTS ACADEMY (CONTINUED)

INTERMEDIATE (AGES 11-13) is a two-week day academy. This level begins training youth in their choice of artistic tracks: mass communications, featuring creative writing, photography and video production, or performing arts, which offers a rotation of theater, instrumental music and storytelling. Participants receive instruction tailored for their age and skill levels facilitated by professional artists.

CHICKASAW ARTS ACADEMY MAJORS (AGES 14-18) is an immersive art instruction experience during a two-week overnight residential academy. Majors participants are housed in the ECU dorms and have access to campus amenities, giving them a taste of college life as well. These students gain experience in their choice of mediums including drawing, painting, contemporary pottery, metalsmithing, creative writing, culinary arts, performance theater, dance, vocal music, music industry, digital arts, photography, printmaking, theater technology, video production, fashion design, costume design and more.

The **TRIBAL BURIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM** will pay up to \$5,000 directly to the funeral home to supplement the final balance of a Chickasaw citizen's required burial expenses. The program cannot reimburse families.

Verification of citizenship, Social Security card, death certificate, final funeral home statement, verification of deceased's address and residence must be provided within six months following the date of death.

SPECIAL TRIBAL LANDS DRAW HUNT

Deer and turkey licensee permits are available through the Chickasaw Nation Fish & Wildlife Service for the special tribal lands draw hunt. General season small game, archery and migratory bird hunting opportunities are also available.



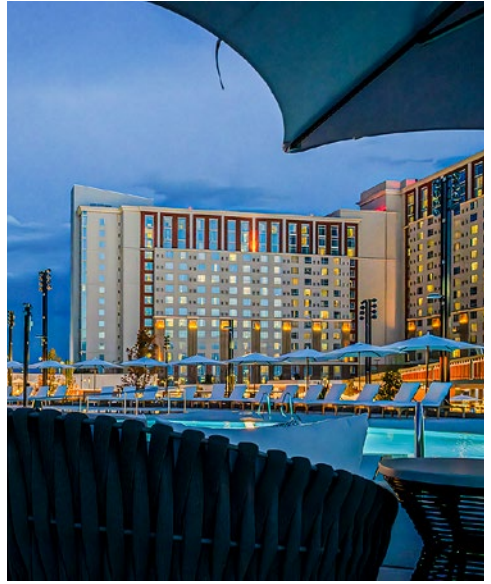

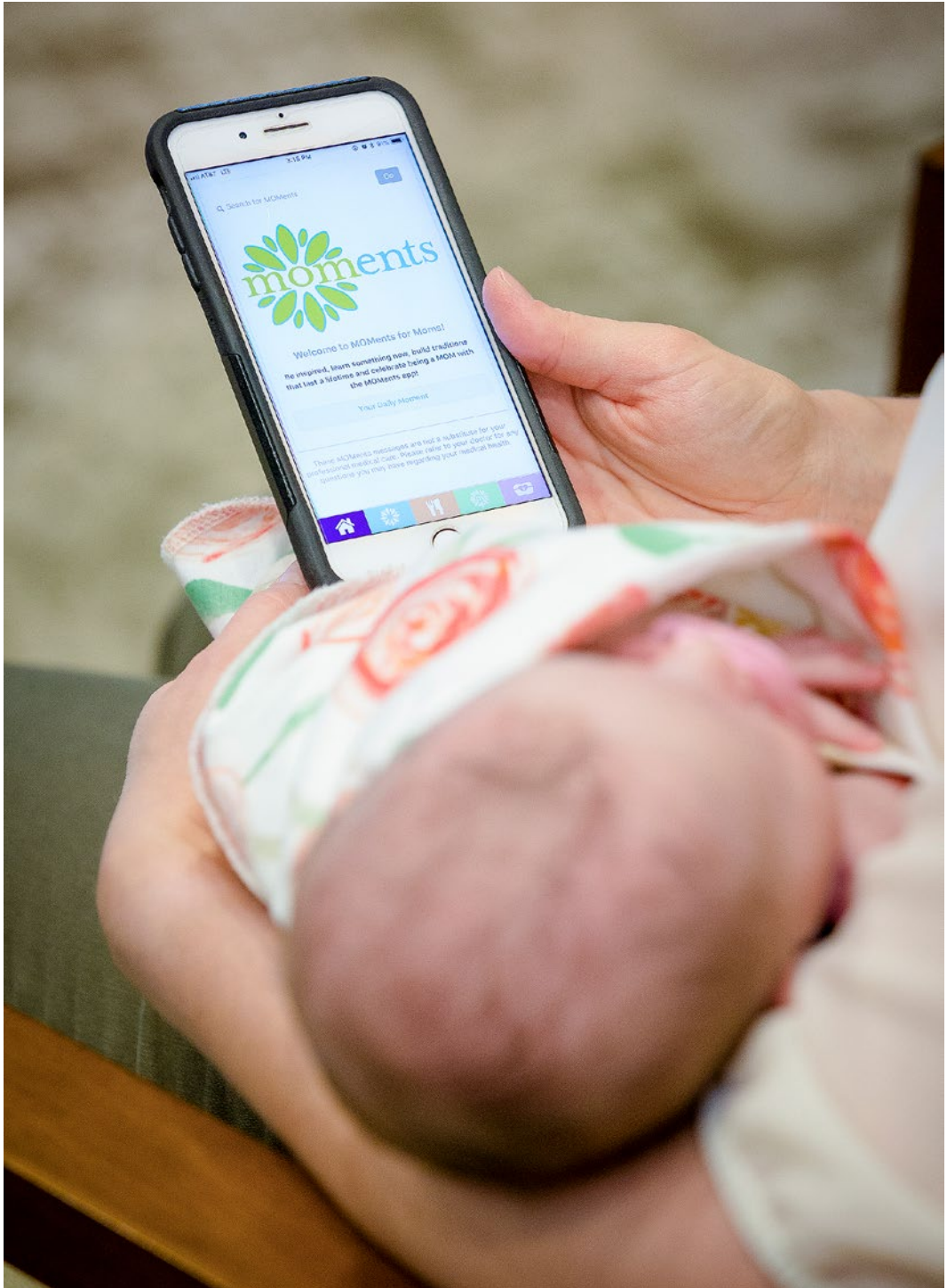
