Verification of citizenship, Social Security card, death certificate, final funeral home statement, verification of deceased's address and residence must be provided within six months following the date of death.

A **GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP** may be awarded to an undergraduate, graduate or doctoral student enrolled in three or more credit hours who maintains a minimum 3.0 GPA each semester. Awards are based on enrollment and classification, and incentives are available based on GPA.

The GOVERNOR'S, LT. GOVERNOR'S AND LEGISLATOR'S SCHOLARSHIPS are each awarded to one graduating high school senior who has achieved a high level of academic success. To be eligible for these scholarships, a student must have earned a 3.85 GPA or higher or have been selected class valedictorian or salutatorian.

A LAPTOP SCHOLARSHIP is available to Chickasaw college students one time during their college careers if they have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher, are enrolled in at least 12 college credit hours and are at least at a sophomore level.






