This show is an exciting opportunity to showcase the strength, spirit and creativity of Chickasaw women, including their art, during this conference. The artwork will be exhibited until May 31.

Guideline:

- Artists may submit up to three entries in the show. Please contact us if you will be shipping your artwork.
- All artwork should be ready to hang for display. All artwork will be displayed in a secure environment and will be viewed by hundreds of visitors during this year's conference and forum.
- Please have your artwork priced if you would like it for sale, or marked, "Not for Sale."
- Complete the artist information form (included in this packet).
- Complete the release of liability agreement (included in this packet).

Deadlines for participation and intake:

Release of Liability

I, _____, the undersigned, hereby acknowledge that I give my permission to include my artwork, if any, for participation in the Art of the Chickasaw Woman exhibit and show sponsored by the Chickasaw Nation and that, in consideration of my participation, I willingly and knowingly execute this release of liability.

I acknowledge that such participation carries with it the potential of property damage or loss of artwork due to handling, packing, transport or exhibition of artwork for public viewing. With a full understanding of the potential risks, I do voluntarily and knowingly execute this release of liability associated with such participation with the expressed intention of effecting a release of all claims, both in tort and in contract, past, present and future, known or unknown, of every kind, character and description, and I hereby take this action for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns.

I, the undersigned, agree not to sue the Chickasaw Nation and its employees for any of the claims or liabilities that I have waived, released or discharge herein, and I indemnify and hold harmless the Chickasaw Nation from any claims made or liabilities assessed against it as a result of submitting artwork for this exhibit. This release of liability should be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum permissible under applicable law. Furthermore, I acknowledge that I have willingly and voluntarily entered into this release and acknowledgment after reviewing this form.

Nothing contained in this release of liability shall be construed to waive the sovereign rights of the Chickasaw Nation, its officers, employees or agents. This release of liability and acknowledgment shall be performed within applicable guidelines, resolutions and ordinances of the Chickasaw Nation. State law shall not be applicable nor shall disputes be subject to any authority outside the Chickasaw Nation.
