- Completed and signed application form.
- Two letters of recommendation.
- Most recent college transcript(s).
- Professional resume.
- Driver's license copy.

Provisions:

Interns will be provided with the following:

- Bi-weekly pay.
- One-time round-trip airfare (or mileage) to and from the internship placement location.
- Housing accommodations.
 - *Please note that lodging is for the intern only. Family and friends cannot be accommodated.

Internship conditions:

To satisfactorily complete the Chickasaw Nation Internship Program, interns must:

- Complete a minimum of six weeks and a maximum of 10 weeks in the *Chickasaw Nation Internship Program*;
- Agree to and abide by the policies set forth by the Chickasaw Nation Internship Program;
- Submit a weekly report of the activities completed;
- Mutually agree on an internship timeframe regarding start and end date;
- Provide all completed documentation including agreement forms, logs, reports and all other items used in the evaluation process on or before established deadlines; and
- Consent to undergo testing for the presence of illicit drugs and alcohol in accordance with the Chickasaw Nation's drug testing policy.
