PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Eligible Chickasaw students can receive reimbursement for fees or expenses in various extracurricular activities, clubs and leagues.

Chickasaw high school seniors are eligible for an additional reimbursement for senior expenses. Graduating seniors are also eligible for an honor cord to recognize Chickasaw students.

AMOUNT:

Up to \$300 fees reimbursement (once per year)

Up to \$300 senior expenses (once per lifetime)

Honor cord (once per lifetime)

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be Chickasaw citizen aged 3 through high school senior
- Expenses must be within current funding year (Oct. 1-Sept. 30)

APPLICATION PROCESS

Apply online at Chickasaw.net/ YouthReimbursement or contact youth services at (580) 310-6620.

Applications may also be submitted in person, by email, fax or mail.

Applications must include proof of cost (can include a flyer, receipt or brochure) for fees or expenses requested for reimbursement.

Amount awarded on Visa card is determined by the amount to be reimbursed to the Citizen based on approved documentation. For example, \$100 in approved documentation receives a \$100 award. \$300 or more in approved documentation results in a \$300 award.











APPLICATION PERIOD

OCTOBER 1 - SEPTEMBER 30

APPROVED EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES Include, but are not limited to:

- Athletics, band, dance, art, etc. (examples: sports equipment, band instruments, dance wear, specialty shoes)
- · Educational trips, conferences or programs
- Educational opportunity fees for organizations like
 FFA, 4-H, DECA, FCCLA, etc. (examples: course fees, membership dues, livestock fees)
- Camp expenses

APPROVED SENIOR EXPENSES Include, but are not limited to:

- · Graduation announcements
- · Cap and gown
- · Class ring
- Letterman jackets
- Senior pictures

UNAPPROVED EXPENSES Include, but are not limited to:

- · Travel, lodging and food expenses
- Driver's test, permit or licensing fees
- Gaming systems and accessories
- Transportation costs (examples: gas, car insurance, car payments)
- Fees or tuition for private education
 (examples: summer school, concurrent college classes, tutoring)
- School supplies (examples: textbooks, vo-tech supplies, backpacks)
- · ACT/SAT classes or testing fees
- Childcare, including daycare, Chickasaw Youth
 Clubs and Chickasaw School Age Program
